Bristol and BTES Lead Sullivan County in Becoming a Certified Connected Community

The city of Bristol, Tennessee, and BTES have led Sullivan County in becoming the first Certified Connected Community in the state of Tennessee by Connected Nation. So what does this mean?

This means that BTES' service area has the broadband infrastructure available, there is current residential use of the technology, and improvements have been made to the quality of life in the community through the technology that is available.

In achieving this designation, our community has demonstrated that we meet or exceed benchmarks for broadband access, broadband adoption and broadband use. This signifies that we possess the necessary broadband infrastructure and digitally proficient workforce required to be truly competitive in today's connected global economy.

BTES' high-speed data system played a major role in meeting this criteria.

"In the early 2000s, BTES' board and staff shared a vision of having a highly connected community," said BTES CEO Mike Browder. "Now we provide a super high-speed data system over fiber, offering speeds of a **Gigabit per second**, which is available to every business and every home in our service area. This continues to allow us to be prepared for future technological needs and growth in our community."

Our community is now one of only 17 communities nationwide, and one of only two in the state of Tennessee, designated as a Connected Community. Sullivan County was challenged to be the first in Tennessee, and the city of Bristol, BTES and others worked hard to meet that goal.

"We couldn't be more excited to r e c o g n i z e Sullivan County as Tennessee's

first Certified Connected Community," said Corey Johns, executive director, Connected Tennessee. "Sullivan County now joins a distinguished group of communities from across the country to achieve certification through Connected Nation's nationally recognized 'Connected' community technology program."





To achieve certification, BTES completed a rigorous application and the community received a thorough assessment. Also, at least 100 points out of 120 were required for certification. *Sullivan County earned a score of 118.*

"The Certified Connected Community signifies an important milestone for Sullivan County's evolving technology landscape and establishes an important benchmark for achieving progress through technology," said Alyson Ferine, state operations manager, East Tennessee at Connected Tennessee.

Connected certification affords a community an avenue to discuss its success and resources, as well as pursue opportunities as a recognized, technologically advanced community. Through this program, communities are creating a better business environment, more effective economic development, enhanced education and more efficient government.

BTES Fights to Keep Cable Rates Low

Our goal at BTES is to manage monthly bills by fighting excessive TV network fee increases that are imposed by large, powerful media conglomerates.

That is why we are a member of the National Cable Television Cooperative (NCTC), a collective of more than 900 independent cable and broadband companies across the United States. This allows us to negotiate as one larger group to gain the cost benefits enjoyed by larger providers, while still enabling us to provide hometown service to our customers.

"We know our customers want a good value," said BTES CEO Mike Browder. "When networks demand huge fee increases, we work to get the best offerings at the best price so that we can keep bills as low as possible."

We know our customers want more choices and control with TV programming. We strive to get networks to offer shows to you on YOUR terms, not theirs.

BTES asks that networks do not hold their channel hostage from our customers while we are negotiating. When networks pull their signal, their goal is for you to negotiate for them — and everyone ends up paying more.

Consolidation among the major network media companies means they have power and programming leverage — and they are not afraid to use it to boost their bottom line at our customers' expense. They may demand excessive fee increases, package unpopular networks with popular ones, remove their programming during the negotiation process, or any combination of these tactics.

Did you also know that:

- Nine media companies control 95 percent of the paid video content consumed in the U.S.
- The average household watches only 16 channels, yet networks package their channels to force you to buy those you don't want in order to get those that you do want.
- Programming network fees account for the bulk of your monthly cable bill.
- The cost of cable has risen 3.5 times the rate of inflation over the past 15 years because of demands from networks for higher programming fees.

For BTES to carry your local broadcast TV stations on our cable system, we must first obtain each station's permission. However, these stations only grant permission when BTES agrees to pay them whatever fee they demand per customer. In addition, these channels must be placed on the tier that has the most customers. This is unfair because you can receive these channels for free by using an antenna.

"This means that our customers pay for the same station that they broadcast free over the air," Browder said. "We don't think this is fair, and we are working to keep these costs in check."

Each year, hundreds of lives are lost and thousands of people are injured because of preventable recreational boating accidents on our nation's waterways. You can enjoy boating and stay safe by following these tips from the U.S. Coast Guard and the National Safe Boating Council:

- Get a list of recommended safety equipment from the Coast Guard and make sure all items are on board and in working condition.
- Make sure everyone on board wears a life jacket that fits properly.
- Avoid alcohol while boating.
- Move around carefully; most small boats capsize because of sudden weight shifts.
- Know and obey navigation rules, operate at a safe speed, and keep a proper lookout.
- Maintain a safe distance from swimmers and skiers.
- Never smoke when fueling.
- Tell someone where you're going and when you'll return.
- Check the weather forecast before getting under way.
- Take a boating safety course.

Best Fruit Salad

Your favorite fruits (strawberries, blueberries, mangos and grapes work well)

In a small bowl, combine melted butter, honey, mustard, salt and pepper; drizzle over potatoes and onion. Bake for 35 minutes or until tender, stirring halfway through the cooking time.
